

DECLARATION CONFIRMING THE ABSENCE OF ANY CONFLICT OF INTEREST

I, the undersigned, Dario DE MEDICI , born in _____ , on _____ ,
tax code _____ , under my own responsibility, pursuant to article 47 of Italian
Presidential Decree no. 445 dated 28th December 2000 - being informed and aware of the criminal
punishment provided for false statements¹ hereby declare the absence of any conflict of interest
and situation of incompatibility - even potential - with the office assigned to me.

Pursuant to Article 2 para. 3 of Italian Presidential Decree no. 62 dated 16.04.2013, I, the
undersigned, also undertake to observe the obligations set out in the Code of Conduct for Public
Servants and the Code of Conduct adopted by the Institute and published in the Transparent
Administration section of the Institute website, as far as said obligations are compatible with the
office assigned to me. Any proved breach of said obligation thereof shall constitute ground for
termination of the contract and removal from office.

As a Professional I am informed and aware that all information about the office entrusted to me
(subject, quantification, method of assignment) and my data, including personal information
(curriculum vitae, absence of conflicts of interest, etc.) will be posted on the Institute website or may
be disclosed in different ways, pursuant to Italian Legislative Decree no. 33/2013 and the provisions
of law on transparency of Public Administration.

¹ Article 76 of Presidential Decree 445/2000 - "1. Anyone who makes false statements or false deeds or makes use of them in the cases set out in this Consolidated Act shall be punished under the Criminal Code and special laws as applicable. 2. Production of a document containing incorrect information that are no longer true is the equivalent to using a false deed. 3. Self declarations made under Articles 46 and 47 and the declarations made on behalf of the persons referred to in Article 4, paragraph 2, shall be treated as made to a public officer. 4. When the offenses referred to in paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 are committed in order to obtain assignment of public office or licence to practice a profession or trade, in the most serious cases the judge may apply temporary disqualification from holding public offices or from practicing a profession or trade".
